

EO 2024 SKC National Team Selection

Six dog-handler teams in each European Open height category (Small, Medium, Intermediate & Large) will win their way into the European Open 2024

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TRIP IS SELF FUNDED

Details of the qualification process are outlined below:

- The **6 highest placed** eligible dogs and handler teams from each height category will be invited to represent Singapore at the European Open 2024 events
- Teams must participate at least **12 FCI Singapore Trials (6 Agility + 6 Jumper) AND 4 SKC Singapore Trials (2 Agility + 2 Jumper)** between **1 May 2023 and 30 April 2024**
- **All points gained from Singapore FCI and SKC Trials during the qualifying period** shall be counted to determine the highest scoring teams
- Minimum qualifying score will be at **50 point per dog team** (under the same handler)
- Teams must be at least at **FCI A2 and FCI J2 level** with **minimum 1 qualified run (clean run) in A2 and J2** respectively under Singapore FCI titling
(PS, for 2025 National Team, dogs shall need to be in A3 & J3 level)
- All dogs qualified to represent Singapore at European Open must be above **24 months** of age upon European Open first trial day.
- Selection process is **OPEN** to all dogs, **with or without pedigree**.

All qualifiers must be citizens of Singapore or Singapore Permanent Residence per accordance to European Open Championship Regulations. All qualifiers dog-handler teams must have valid membership (not expired) of Singapore Kennel Club throughout the duration of European Open Championship competition.

SKC reserves the rights to make the final decision in compliance with European Open rules of max 6 dogs competing under a team in 1 height category. SKC reserved the rights to managed ratio of dog- handler teams per height category accordingly to the overall European Open rules and will make the final decision in team selection.
