<sup>\*\*\*</sup> Please note that chairs will be provided based on the number of entries submitted. Each entry will be provided one chair. Any additional chairs required will be based on per entry, each entry allowed to rent maximum additional 2 chairs. Each entry will be entitled to one entry pass. Any additional entry pass required please tick and indicate quantity required. Friends and supporters are advised to stay around the ring area. Show Manager reserves the right to excuse friends and supporters from the benching area. Chairs will be distributed by SKC staff upon check in.

\*\*\* To avoid electrical power tripping, do not connect more than 3 appliances to each power point.

Additional cost may be borne by the person who has caused the trip.

\*NOTE: Exhibitors without power points ARE NOT ALLOWED to bench at the power point area. If found doing so, exhibitors will be asked to leave the power point area. We seek your kind understanding and cooperation.

Show Manager reserves all rights to withdraw entries of those failing to comply with the regulations.

## Entries and Entry forms

- 1. To be acceptable, an entry must:
  - Be on an Official Singapore Kennel Club entry form;
  - Be signed by the owner;
  - Include all of the following information:
    - ✓ Breed
    - ✓ Sex
    - ✓ Class
    - √ Full/Registered name of dog
    - ✓ Date of Birth of dog
    - ✓ Name of owner
    - ✓ Membership number
    - ✓ Address of owner
    - √ Name of breeder/s
    - √ Name of sire
    - √ Name of dam
    - ✓ SKC registration number (not applicable to NAF dogs)
    - ✓ Handler information:
  - Understand that entries submitted will be considered void if entry fees are not received within 24hours upon payment advise by SKC staff; and
  - Accept all the usual terms and conditions of entries, as stipulated on the Show Entry Form or otherwise.
- 2. EXHIBITORS' RESPONSIBILITY. Exhibitor must ensure that their exhibits compete in the Classes for which they had been entered. The Exhibitor must notify the Ring Steward immediately should the dog be called into the wrong Class.
  - Change of classes at the collecting ring is Not allowed unless there is an administrative mistake in the class that the
    dog is entered in. Only the show secretary/ manager has the discretion to change the classes.
- 3. Members who require the assistance of SKC staff to complete the Show Entry form/s will be charged a processing fee of \$10 per dog. Members MUST:
  - Send in all required information via email or in person at the SKC office:
  - Ensure that all information provided is accurate;
  - Make <u>full payment</u> via PayNow (upon advise by SKC staff) or in cash <u>together with the submission of entry form</u> at SKC Office; and
  - Accept all the usual terms and conditions of entries, as stipulated on the Show Entry Form or otherwise.

#### Late Entries:

In accordance with the FCI Show Rules, we are <u>unable</u> to accept late entries for FCI CACIB shows as well as the APAC CAC shows. This includes entries for conformation and handling competition. <u>No entries will be accepted for all Shows after the closing date and time stated.</u>

#### Classifications and Limitations:

- 1. All dogs will be classified into FCI groupings and there will be 10 Groups.
- 2. SKC Show All SKC Champions <u>must</u> be entered in the Champion class, and further categorized into respective subclasses. All untitled dogs which are unbeaten will compete for the CC.
- 3. FCI Show All Champions (SKC and overseas), 15 months and above, <u>must</u> be entered in the Champion class. All non-Champions or Champions (SKC and overseas), less than 15 months may compete based on their age. Only dogs 15 months and above competing in the <u>Intermediate</u>, <u>Open</u> and <u>Champion</u> classes and obtain a 1<sup>st</sup> Excellent grade are eligible to compete for the CACIB. The Best junior, CACIB winner and best veteran from both sexes, if awarded excellent, will compete with FCI champions for Best of Breed (BOB).
- 4. Except where there is a direct reference in the definition to the age of the exhibit, it is a condition that all exhibits should be aged not less than 6 months at the commencement of the show.
- 5. Minor puppies will be judged in one category/ event.

## Dog Welfare And Health At Dog Shows

The exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of the dogs at the Dog Show. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that can be dangerous for its health and welfare, such as for example leaving it in the air-conditioned car in excessively hot and/ or treating it in a cruel manner. Violation of this ruling will result in exclusion from the ongoing and future dog shows.

#### Canine Viral Gastroenteritis:

Members are strongly advised in their own interest and in the interest of others to have their dogs immunized against the above-mentioned disease, which is a highly contagious disease.

#### Withdrawals:

- 1. Members are reminded that bitches on heat will not be allowed to compete. If a bitch is found to be on heat during the Show, all awards will be withdrawn and the owner will be required to remove the bitch from the Show premises. The owner may also be suspended from showing at the next SKC Championship Show.
- 2. There will be no refund of entry fees for bitches in season and withdrawals.

#### Other notes to exhibitors:

- 1. Do remember to keep the show grounds/ venue clean and clean up after your dog/s.
- 2. Exhibitors with <u>Category B dogs</u> are required to muzzle them at all times at the Show Ground, even at the Benching Area. The muzzle can only be removed at the Collecting Ring.
- 3. Show Manager reserves all rights to excuse exhibitor from show and withdraw all awards if a handler is found not SKC member.
- 4. Show timing will be planned accordingly to the total number of entries. Exhibitors with more than one breed please ensure you have sufficient handlers.
